(video commented by Z. Gabelica) (in French) "Since many years I'm fascinated by tektites, those little black or green glass drops whose origin seems to defy all physical laws" claims Guy upon introducing his worldwide recognized book entitled as the present lecture. Who better than him could initiate us to these so strange "objects"?

Thematic exhibits: Many outstanding tektites and some selected impactites from two advanced collections (O. Gabel & Z. Gabelica) will be displayed within the Regency museum windows, accompanied by original data collected during expeditions in the Philippines, and Cambodia and related to appropriate hunting stories & anecdotes.

Another window presenting the newly created "<u>Mars Society Belgium</u>", including information on future Mars missions and showing some Martian meteorites, will be set in the Spiess room (1st floor) next to 3 replicas of ARIANE rockets (on loan from CNES), all commented by E.
